- Has faith changed your life? Does having faith make your life different from those who do not have faith?
- What does your faith ask of you as a member of the Church of Christ believers? (Colossians 2:6-7; John 15:12)
- How has believing in God made a difference to you?
- How has believing in Jesus Christ made a difference to you?
- Does believing in the Holy Spirit make a difference for you in your understanding of faith?

Using this to guide you, think about how you experience faith and your faith life? How do you see faith as part of your personal life? ... as part of the public sharing of faith with other believers and non-believers? (1 Peter 3:15; Matthew 5:15, 16)
